The concept of utilising natural hot springs for health was initiated and then developed by the Japanese when they governed Taiwan from 1895 to 1945

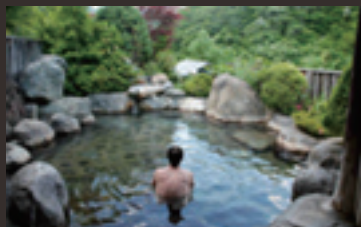
Yangmingshan Hot Spring area, where the numerous streams of hot water bubble out of the scenic slopes and its salt alkali springs which range in temperature from 40 to 50°C are believed to be good for relieving joint and muscle pain, skin conditions and gout.

Wulai Hot Spring area, famous outer urban 'hot' retreat south of the capital of Taiwan, its 48 to 55°C sulphur waters are said to be good for relieving arthritis pain and gout.

Wulai is also home to a colourful aboriginal group, visitors can also sample the tribal foods and purchase well-made handi-crafts.

Located an hour northeast of the south capital city of Kaohsiung, Sihjhong Creek Hot Spring Area is not only surrounded by mountain beauty it has a special entertainment area that is popular with locals and visitors alike

DAY 1: ARRIVAL

Evening flight arrive Taipei Int'l Airport, to be met and being transferred to hotel. At leisure Hotel: Riverview Hotel, Taipei

DAY 2: TAIPEI CITY / KEELUNG / YEH LIU / TAIPEI CITY (B/L/D)

After breakfast, we proceed to Keelung to visit Chung Ching Park where you can view the huge statue of the Goddess of Mercy and also a panoramic view of Keelung Harbor. Then we continue to Yehliu famed for its numerous rock formations resembling a Queen's head, Fairy Shoe and Lover's Rock. Return to Taipei around 12 noon for lunch. Afternoon tour of Taipei City, which includes the impressive C.K.S. Memorial Hall, National Palace Museum where 5,000 years of Chinese Imperial arts and jade collections are exhibited, Martyrs' Shrine of traditional architecture and Taipei Handicraft Center. After dinner, transfer back to hotel, or you may choose stopover at Taipei 101. Hotel: Riverview Hotel, Taipei

DAY 3: Yangmingshan Hot Spring / Wulai (Taipei) (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, and then transfer to Yangmingshan which located Taipei Urban Area and covers the forest that used to be called Grass Mountain. To the north faces ocean and the south is the Taipei Basin. Geological features created by activity of the Datun-shan Volcano. The hot spring water of Yangmingshan is mostly clear, but some of the springs produce a greenish water. It is effective in treating skin diseases, hardening of the arteries, and rheumatism. Afternoon tour to Wulai Aboriginal Village, where you can enjoy a Taiwanese push car ride. Wulai is a famous mountain village in northern Taiwan and is located in water reservation area. Residents are most aboriginal people (Tai Ya Tribe). The famous Wulai Waterfall is about 80 meters high. It is magnificent like a white silk cloth coming down from the sky. The highlight of the visit to the center is the singing and dancing show of aboriginal people. Hotel: Riverview Hotel, Taipei (3 star)

DAY 4: Taipei / Bullet Train / Kaohsiung / Sihjongsii Hot Spring / Kenting (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, and then transfer to Taipei Bullet Train Station, take bullet train from Taipei to Kaohsiung, upon arrival to be transferred to Sihjongsii Hot Spring Area by private vehicle. Sihjongsii Hot Spring Area is located at Checheng Township in Pingtung County. The water here is carbonated and said to be good for treating skin conditions, nerve and other chronic ailments. The water ingredients include many kinds of minerals which are excellent for promoting circulation and relieving stiff muscles. The carbonated water here is clear and transparent, and good for drinking. Evening transfer to Kenting, Riverview Hotel, Taipei

DAY 5: Kenting / Sandimen / Kaohsiung (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, proceed to Sandimen, tour Sandimen Taiwan Aboriginal Culture Park, centre of Taiwanese tribal art and culture. The park has traditional tribal cabins, including Tai Ya, Sai Hsia, A Mei, Ya Mei, Tsao, Pu Nung, Pai Wan and Lu Kai. The cabins are located according to each tribe's tradition and lifestyle. There are a wax figure room, a multimedia room and an exhibition room in the park, presenting the development and culture of the aboriginal tribes. The handicraft room shows how the aborigines create their unique handicrafts, and many more. After lunch, we will proceed to Kaohsiung City which is the biggest city in southern Taiwan. We will enjoy seafood dinner at Chijin restaurant, after dinner tour of Love River and Leo Ho Night Market and then check in hotel. Hotel: Toong Mao Hotel, Kaohsiung

DAY 6: Kaohsiung City Tour / Bullet Train / Taipei (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, then starting Kaohsiung City Tour. Located in the southern part of Taiwan, the city of Kaohsiung is the island's largest industrial center. Taiwan's recent progress and prosperity; expanding and modernizing, the city strides into the 21st century as a newly emerging international metropolis. We will visit the famous scenic area in Kaohsiung such as Spring & Autumn Pavilions, Former British Consulate, Dream Mall. After dinner, transfer to Bullet Train Station, take bullet train back to Taipei and then transfer back to hotel. Hotel: Riverview Hotel, Taipei

DAY 7: Taipei/Departure

Taipei, free at leisure After breakfast at hotel, you would have all day free at leisure, you can take a ride on the Taipei Skytrain (MRT), or plan your own shopping tour at some famous Taipei shopping centre, i.e Taipei 101. At 19:00, be ready at the hotel lobby and then transfer to the airport for the departure flight (End of tour)
